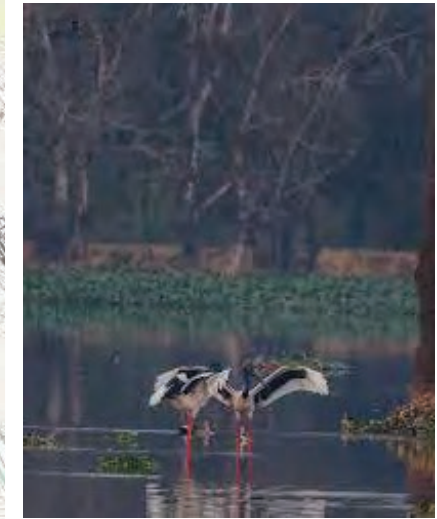
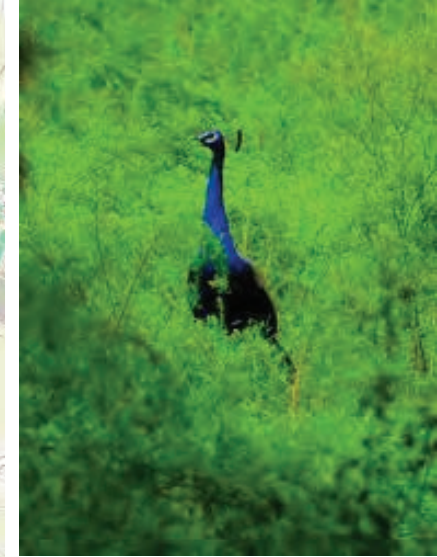
“LANDSCAPE DESIGN | WELLNESS RETREAT GARDEN”

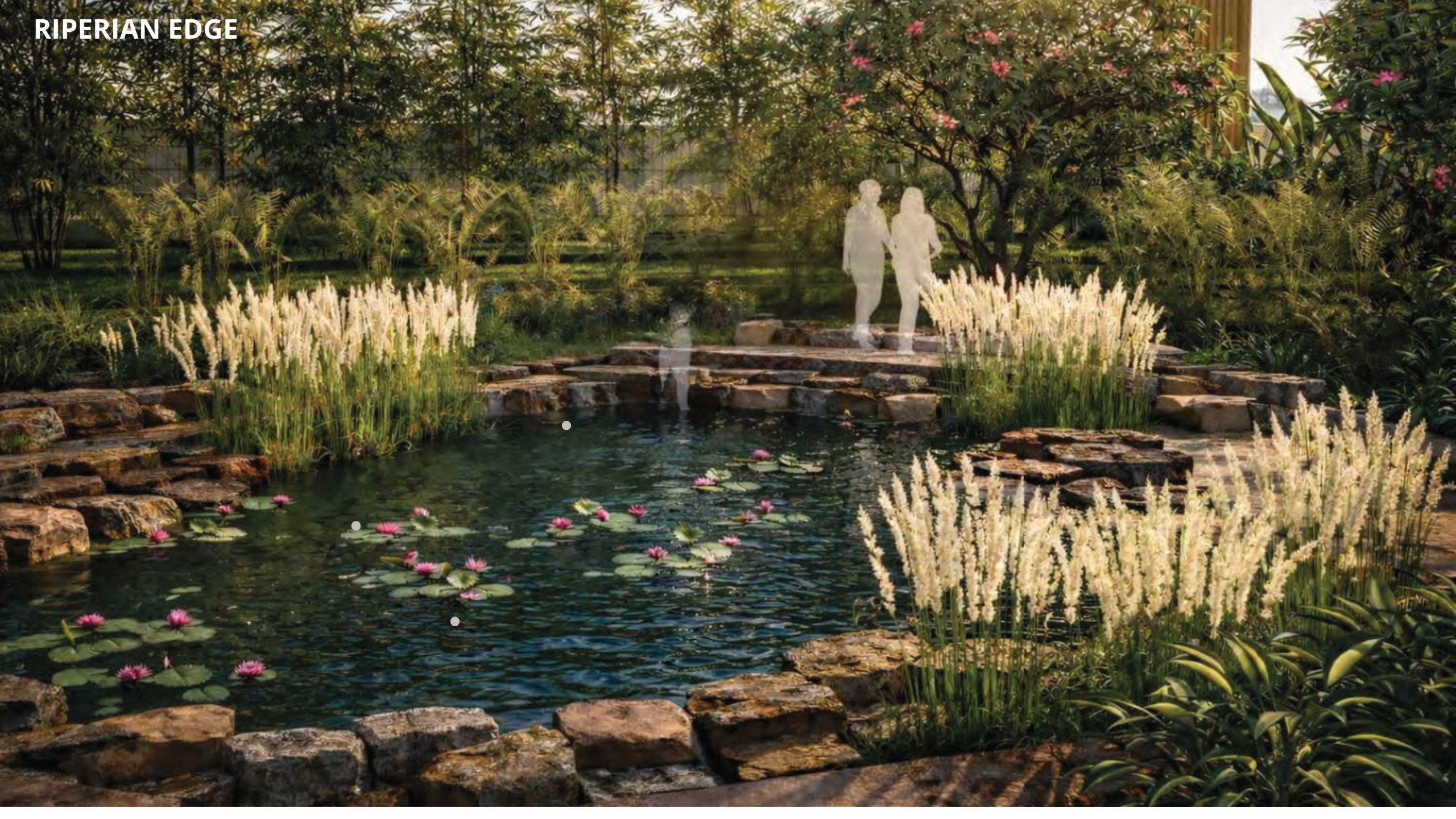

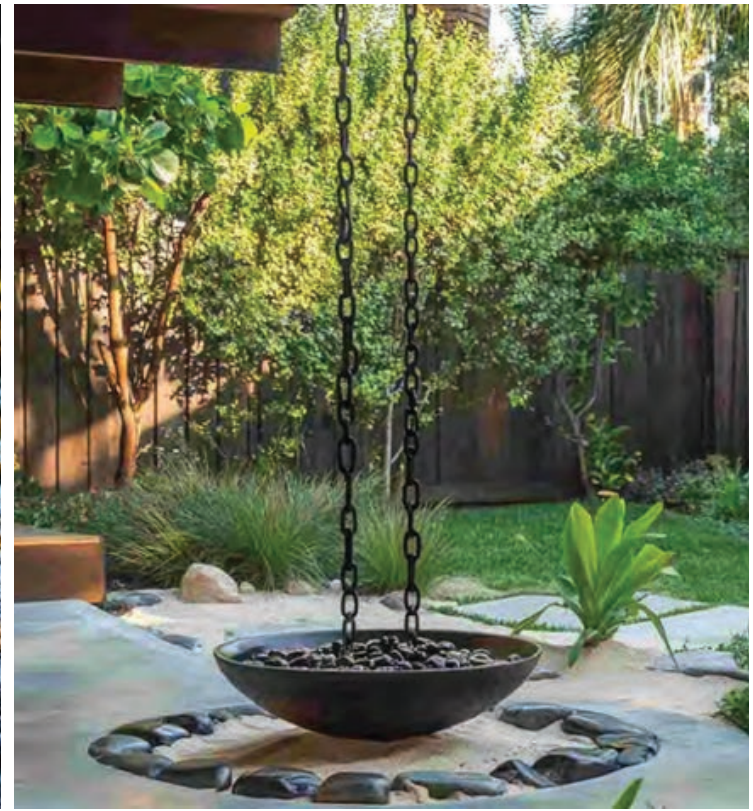

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“FACADE DESIGN | ELEMENTS”



LANDMARK ICON - CROWN

A distinctive, sculpted crown caps, creating a strong skyline identity and establishing the building as a recognizable urban landmark.



VERTICALITY

Vertical fins, textured wall planes and recessed glazing emphasize height while introducing subtle material contrast and depth to the façade.



PLAY OF TEXTURE

Continuous vertical bands with varied textures, balcony projections and recessed panels create a strong sense of height and a refined façade rhythm.



SOFT EDGES & FLUID FORM

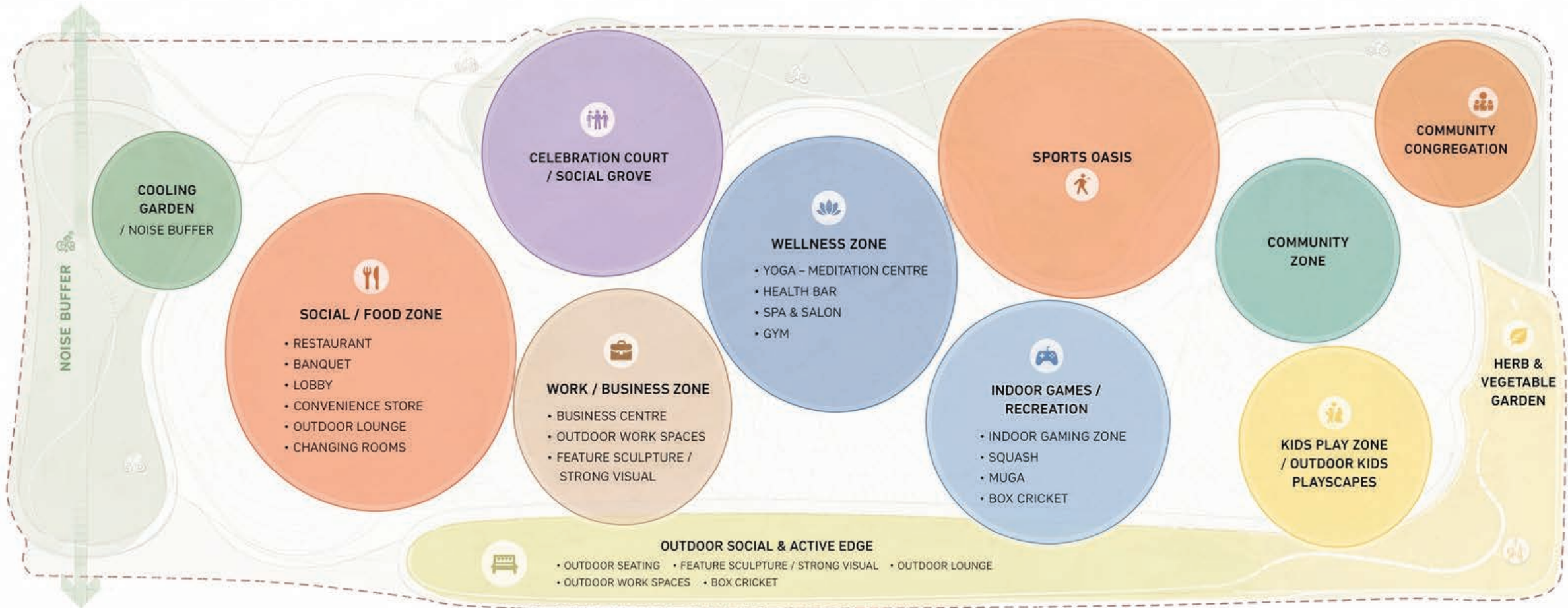
Curved elements at the crown and balcony lines introduce visual flow, reducing rigidity and enhancing façade elegance.

An outdoor TT table, which can be a quick game, under semi-shaded area for the community



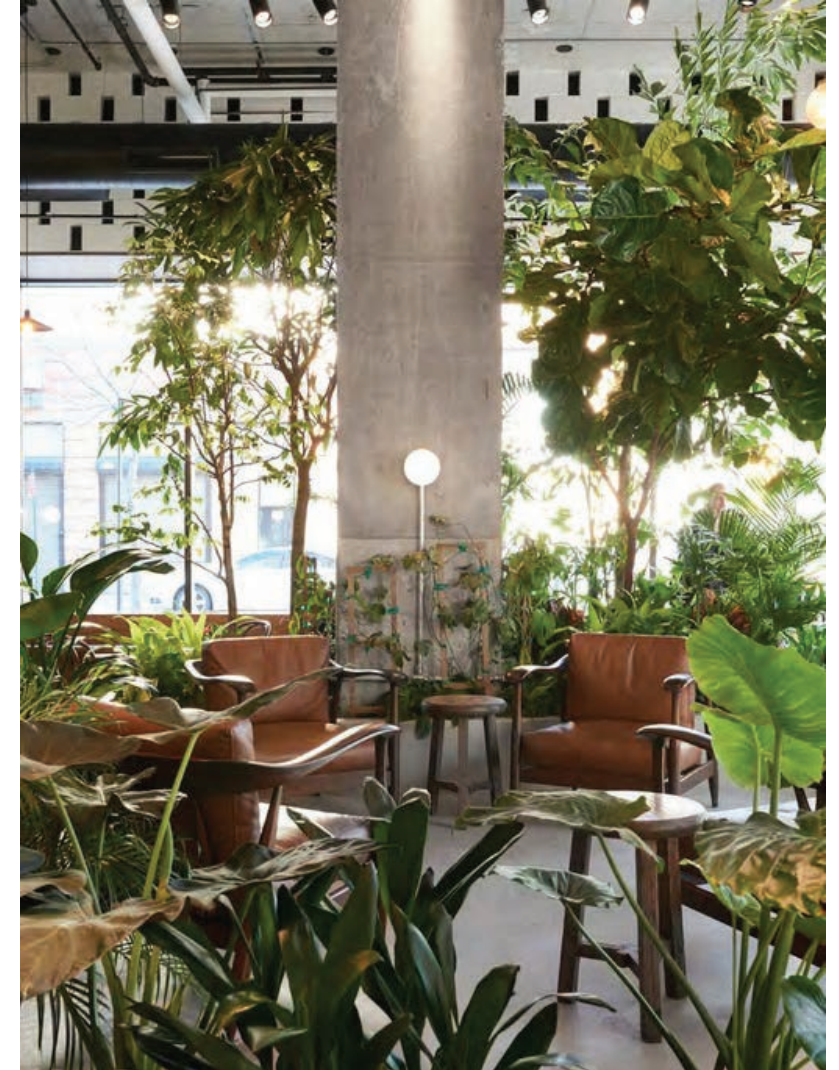
SENIOR CITIZEN SPACE
